

## POLICY STATEMENT

### CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL IN PARKS AND RESERVES POLICY

POLICY ADOPTED: 17 JUNE 2008

---

#### Policy Objective:

The purpose of the policy is to prevent the unauthorised consumption of alcohol on Council controlled parks and reserves and provide a mechanism for local police to aid in the prevention of alcohol related crime on Council controlled land.

#### Policy Statement:

##### 1. Parks and Reserves

The consumption and taking of alcohol is prohibited **at all times** in the following areas:

- a. Barnado Park, West Wyalong
- b. McCann Park, West Wyalong
- c. Lions Park, West Wyalong
- d. The Rose Garden, West Wyalong
- e. Northcott Street Park, West Wyalong
- f. Monash Street Park, West Wyalong
- g. Apex Park, West Wyalong
- h. Rotary Park, West Wyalong
- i. Coinda Bushland Reserve, Wyalong
- j. Herridge Park, Wyalong
- k. Boronia Park, Wyalong
- l. Holland Park, West Wyalong
- m. Holland Park Pool, West Wyalong
- n. Bing Walder Park, Ungarie
- o. Henderson Park, Ungarie
- p. Ungarie Swimming Pool, Ungarie
- q. Queen Street Park, Barmedman
- r. Memorial Park, Barmedman
- s. Memorial Park, Tallimba
- t. Pioneer Park, Weethalle

Signage advising of these restrictions should read:

*The unauthorised consumption and possession of alcohol on this reserve is prohibited under s632 Local Government Act 1993, unless permitted by the Council.  
Maximum Penalty: Ten(10) Penalty Units*

## 2. Ron Crowe Oval

Persons may not take alcohol into Ron Crowe Oval. (Alcohol may be sold at the ground).

Signage advising of these restrictions should read:

<p><i>The taking of alcohol into Ron Crowe Oval is prohibited under s632 Local Government Act 1993, unless permitted by the Council. Maximum Penalty: Ten (10) Penalty Units</i></p>

## 3. Park Street Recreation Ground, Perseverance Street Oval and Redman Oval

The consumption of alcohol is prohibited between the hours of 10:00pm and 10:00am

Signage advising of these restrictions should read:

<p><i>The unauthorised consumption and possession of alcohol is prohibited between 10:00pm and 10:00am under s632 Local Government Act 1993, unless permitted by the Council. Maximum Penalty: Ten (10) Penalty Units</i></p>

Notwithstanding these provisions, the General Manager may issue permits to persons and/or organisations allowing the consumption and taking of alcohol in these areas for any reasonable social purpose and or/entertainment.
