Library to launch Summer Reading Club

The Bland Shire library will hold a launch party for its popular Summer Reading Club on Friday, November 30.

Aimed at local school aged children between five and 16 years of age, the Summer Reading Club theme for 2012-2013 is "Untangled Tales" which promises to take members on a journey of discovery about the many different places books can take you while also providing an opportunity to win some great prizes and enjoy summer fun with friends.

The Summer Reading Club is an annual event encouraging children across the Bland Shire to develop their literacy skills and a love for reading over the long Christmas Break.
