Local Grants Commission Presentation

Tuesday 3 May

Bland Shire Council Chambers at 9am

The NSW Local Government Grants Commission will visit Bland Shire Council on Tuesday 3 May 2016 from 9am in the Council Chambers for approximately two hours.

The Commission makes recommendations on the allocation of federally funded financial assistance grants to NSW councils. Council's 2015-16 grant entitlement amounts to \$6.8 million.

The purpose of the meeting is for the Commission to explain its operations and the basis of its calculations.

The Commission will also give Council the opportunity to highlight the significance of its road network and the shortfall in State and Federal Government funding to allow Council to maintain such a network to an acceptable standard.

Members of the public are also welcome to attend.

Saturday 10 September from 8am to 6pm - Election day
