PROPOSAL FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF ALCOHOL FREE ZONE

Pursuant to Sections 644 & 644A of the *Local Government Act 1993*, Council proposes to establish an alcohol free zone that includes the following locations (refer to table below). It is proposed that the alcohol free zone will operate for a period of four (4) years.

Bland Shire Council, at its meeting on 15 September 2015, resolved to place the Payment of Expenses and Provision of Facilities to Councillors Policy on public exhibition.

Section 252(1) of the Local Government Act 1993 requires that at the end of each year, a Council must adopt a policy concerning the payment of expenses incurred, or to be incurred by, and the provision of facilities to the Mayor, the Deputy Mayor and other Councillors in relation to discharging the functions of civic office.
